Training & an Interactive Workshop at Chiktan Block



An interactive workshop was conducted with the Community Health Workers (CHW), including ANMs and Community Health Officers (CHO) of Chiktan Block, on May 29, 2023.

The workshop focused on enhancing the understanding and skills of CHWs to create Health IDs/ABHA from various interfaces, resolving multiple technical issues, and linking health records from different programmes, especially Non-Communicable Diseases (NCD) and Reproductive and Child Health (RCH) with ABHA.

ABDM believes that CHWs are the most critical human resource who can spearhead the country's digital health initiative at the ground level and ensure the linkage of health records with ABHA so that citizens can digitally access and store all their health records in one place.
