Visit of Expert for CIPS Award



The Centre for Innovations in Public Systems (CIPS) is a national body with a mission to help create and nurture a climate for accelerating and diffusing innovations in public systems. Recently, UT Ladakh's presentation on the "Implementation of ABDM with the integration of e-hospital in Ladakh" was shortlisted by the Expert Committee and advanced to the third stage for the final awards.

In this regard, Dr. Reshma M Gopan, Assistant Professor at the Dr. Kakarla Subba Rao Centre for Healthcare Management at the Administrative Staff College of India (ASCI), Hyderabad, visited SNM Hospital Leh and the Primary Health Centre Basgo. She engaged in discussions with various health professionals to validate the data presented during the interaction with the Experts (online).

Outreach Camp

The monthly health mela was held at the Community Hall in Skalzangling Leh on 14th of September. This event brought together a convergence of healthcare programs, each making a significant contribution to the enhancement of community health. ABDM also actively participated in the event, extending its support by providing services related to the Ayushman Bharat Health Account (ABHA). More than 50 ABHAs were created for the beneficiaries, and the health mela served as an effective platform for the immediate resolution of various queries and concerns related to the utilization of ABHAs. Attendees were provided with a unique opportunity to seek clarification and guidance on-site, ensuring the seamless and efficacious utilization of this invaluable healthcare resource.



Workshop in Zanskar Block

An interactive workshop was conducted with the Auxiliary Nurse & Midwives and Community Health Officers of Zanskar Block on 21 and 22 of September. The workshop primarily focused on enhancing the understanding and skills of these professionals in creating ABHA from various interfaces, resolving multiple technical issues, and linking health records across different programs. As a part of the "Ayushman Bhavah" initiative, the training also included registering the frontline healthcare workers as operators on the Ayushman App to allow them to create PMJAY cards for citizens at the community level.

Ladakh on the Top in UT Category

At the "Arogya Manthan" event held on September 25th and 26th, 2023, at Vigyan Bhawan in New Delhi, ABDM UT Ladakh was honored with the prestigious "Top UT" award in the UT category. This recognition was bestowed upon ABDM UT Ladakh for achieving the highest number of digital health record connections with ABHA between October 2022 and September 2023. The award was presented by the esteemed Minister of State for Health and Family Welfare and Additional CEO of the National Health Authority.
